Experiential Group Facilitators

Experience and Knowledge Required:

Ideally a Certificate in Group Facilitation / Group Analysis or equivalent qualification or working towards this.

We would also consider applicants who do not have a specific group qualification but who:

- can demonstrate relevant competence and experience of conducting groups within a psychodynamic setting.
- have trained with a recognised training organisation whose orientation is in psychodynamic counselling/ psychodynamic psychotherapy
- are currently practicing as a psychodynamic counsellor/ psychodynamic psychotherapist, preferably with 5 years' post qualification experience.
- has accreditation with the BACP/UKCP/IGA/BPS/BPC or working towards accreditation would be an advantage.
- are receiving regular supervision for therapeutic work that aligns with BACP requirements

Chelmsford Counselling Foundation (CCF)'s training is accredited by BACP.

We have been delivering psychodynamic training for more than 50 years and are currently recruiting Group Facilitators to conduct experiential/process groups, for the Certificate in Counselling Skills course and The Diploma in Psychodynamic Counselling course for Clinical Years.

We are looking for Group Facilitators to conduct a Certificate in Counselling Skills experiential group on Wednesdays, 8:20pm to 9:50pm and The Diploma in Psychodynamic Counselling course for Clinical Years on six Saturdays, spread throughout the academic year. (dates can be provided)

There are two sessions on the Saturday, 10am-11:30am and 12:30pm-2pm.

Groups meet during term time with full emphasis given to enabling the students to observe and experience the unconscious at work, their own and others in an approach compatible with the aims and ethos of the Foundation.

The Group Facilitator is also required to submit a written assessment of the students' use of the group twice a year and attend termly training staff meetings.
